Group Video Projects Fall 2011:

Each student participated in a Group Video Project, which involved the re-enactment of a key sequence from *Beowulf* or one of its primary analogues grounded in a specific location, such as the Meadhall, Dragon's Lair, Grave Mound, Water Troll's Lair, etc. In the Fall of 2011, student video projects were set in the bedchamber of Holofernes, the Meadhall of Heorot, and in the depths of the ocean. The intellectual challenge was to envision how a sense of place permeates a given scene.
