Arranged Marriage

- Financially in control & you arrange the marriage.
- Prevents more better spouses from娶husbands. (Graffiti in text book)
- Prevents pregnancy and premarital sex.
- Decision between love vs meritocratic test that it will choose better.
- No women's choice of choosing a better spouse.
- The involvement of parents gives more motivation to make the marriage work.
- Union of two groups (families) not just two individuals.

• Reproduction is very important

- Select a spouse from a worthy group
- Solidifies parent-child ties
- A way to increase social status

Bridewealth

- Cognitification - exchange occurs for wife and to bride's family for losing a man.
- Prevents husband's divorce because one would have to return the objects & solidifies the marriage.
- Hinder women's premarital sex.
- It publicly signifies the worth of the bride.
- Grants security to bride in case husband dies (his family has invested in her and will continue the support her care her children) - (never died).

Polygyny

- Limited amounts of land/labor
- Prevents husband has more offspring
- wives may have to endure neglect
- men are dominant - have more wives
- Prevents premarital sex & pregnancy
