Arranged Marriage

- Usually arranged when children are young - the parents determine children make arrangements without themselves. So they don't for them - convenient for both sides; no need to make decision.
- Aims at bonding 2 clans together through marriage - union of 2 groups, not couple - individuals - can be used as a tool to raise one's status in the situation of the family
- Security of having a husband - no worrying about being single forever - women don't have to make themselves scarce - maintaining parent / child ties
- Provides the bride security in case her husband dies; ensures she will be taken care of by his family even after that - compensation to the bride's family for losing an important laborer

Bridewealth

- Could be seen as insurance of fidelity - if true w. he leaves the husband then the husband has to give her bridewealth back - stimulates monogamy -
- Want to show respect to the woman her family - not so much purchasing a wife so much as indicating their interest & willingness to participate - shows that the marriage will enter into legitimacy -
- Although it shouldn't be seen as a purchase, a marriage is a huge investment on all sides -
- Grants the bride security in case her husband dies; ensures she will be taken care of by his family even after that -
- Compensation to the bride's family for losing an important laborer

Polygyny

- Allows it possible for barren women to get married & lead a somewhat normal life, if there are other wives to produce children
- Economic benefit - in the fact that it produces many laborers for the family -
- Eases the workload of the women -
