Refer to course materials, particularly the excerpts from The Forest People read for today, to list distinct ways that non-Western societies deal with the conflicts that inevitably arise when people a) live in small communities, in face-to-face contact, day after day; and/or b) when individuals err from social norms and act in socially inappropriate behavior despite strong measures of social control.
