## Directions to NMRC/WRAIR

From the North (Baltimore)

1. Take 95 South.
2. Merge onto Capital Beltway I-495 West.
3. Take Exit 31A, Georgia Ave South towards Silver Spring.
4. Turn South onto Georgia Avenue.
5. Go to the second light and turn right onto Seminary Road (Not Seminary Place).
6. Seminary Road becomes Linden Lane.
7. Turn slight left onto Brookville Road.
8. Turn right onto Stephen Sitter Avenue. It is a small brown sign on the right. Look for the larger brown sign with United States Army Walter Reed Army Medical Center written on it.
9. Large parking lot is approximately 200 yards on the left.
10. Park in any open space that is not reserved. NMRC/WRAIR is a large brick building with blue and gold trim on your right.
11. You can enter the building through the main entrance off of Robert Grant Avenue.
12. We will meet you at security sign in desk.

From the South (Virginia) or North (270S/Germantown/Frederick)

1. Take the I-495 North/Capital Beltway ramp towards Fairfax/Rockville or 270 South towards D.C.
2. Merge onto Capital Beltway I-495.
3. Take the MD-97 South/Georgia Ave exit number 31B towards Silver Spring.
4. Merge onto Georgia Avenue.
5. Go to the second light and turn right onto Seminary Road (Not Seminary Place).
6. Seminary Road becomes Linden Lane.
7. Turn slight left onto Brookville Road.
8. Turn right onto Stephen Sitter Avenue. It is a small brown sign on the right. Look for the larger brown sign with United States Army Walter Reed Army Medical Center written on it.
9. Large parking lot is approximately 200 yards on the left.
10. Park in any open space that is not reserved. NMRC/WRAIR is a large brick building with blue and gold trim on your right.
